Testing Guidelines for Batch Transactions

Helpful Information for Providers/Vendors testing X12 formats:

- It is suggested a minimum of 25, but no more than 50 claims/requests be submitted for each line of business you wish to test
- Test files are submitted via SFTP reference the Quick Start Guide provided upon enrollment
- The **ISA15** should equal **T**
- The trading partner is responsible for downloading and reviewing acknowledgments, which are available within 1 hour after transmission. Please refer to the <u>Acknowledgments Manual</u> for further information
- Contact the EDI Help Desk with any questions regarding testing or acknowledgments, 1-800-472-6481, opt. 1


• The trading partner may request production status once a test file passes with 10% or fewer errors

7. PAYER SPECIFIC BUSINESS RULES AND LIMITATIONS

- 1. ASK accepts Basic and Extended Code Sets
- 2. Transmissions submitted without a valid Trading Partner number will be rejected
- 3. Data that is not valid based on the implementation guide will cause files to be rejected
- 4. Filenames must not contain any of the following: \$ & + , / : ; = ? @
- 5. For Internet File Transmissions: Filenames must contain only alphabetical, numeric, hyphen, or underscore characters. Hyphen and underscore are not acceptable as the first or last character
- 6. A unique filename for each transmission is encouraged i.e., 123KS837P.CCYYMMDD*.*

- 7. 5000 claims will be accepted per ST-SE
- 8. ASK will attempt to provide 60 days' advance notice regarding edit changes or additions, notice will be posted to News | ASK-EDI
- 9. All lower-case characters submitted on an inbound 837 file will be converted to upper case when sending data to the payers processing system
- 10. Patient Control/Claims Submitter's Identifier The ASC X12 TR3 allows up to 38 characters in the 2300 Loop, CLM01; however, the 835 Claim Payment/Advice CLP01 returns a maximum of 20 characters
- 11. 277CA The Payer Claim Control Number, reported in the 2200D REF02 when REF01 = 1K, is used by the ASK Front End Processor and does not reflect a claim control number assigned by the payer. Payers will not have access to this number and cannot provide information based on the 2200D REF02
- 12. **BCBSKS**: Primary remittance advice information must be included when sending secondary claims, 2320 MOA (Medicare Outpatient Adjudication) is required
- 13. **BCBSKS**: Claims submitted for network pricing services must be submitted with the 2000B SBR03 Reference Identifier (Group Number) from the Member ID card
- 14. BCBSKC: Medicare primary information required at line level 2430
- 15. **BCBSKC**: Effective January 1, 2021, Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas City (Blue KC) requires the use of Provider Taxonomy Codes on Professional (837P) and Institutional (837I) claims. Claims missing the provider's taxonomy on the claim will result in a rejection
- 16. **BCBSKS Medicare Advantage**: Effective August 12, 2025, a valid taxonomy code will be required on all Medicare Advantage (MA) professional and institutional claims. Claims missing a valid provider taxonomy will result in a rejection

8. ACKNOWLEDGMENTS AND/OR REPORTS

ASK will return the 999, 277CA, and TA1 as appropriate in response to 837 transactions. Trading partners are responsible for reviewing acknowledgments. Reference: <u>Acknowledgments Manual</u>

A Trading Partner is defined as any ASK (provider, billing service, software vendor, employer group, financial institution, etc.) that transmits to, or receives electronic data from ASK.

The Trading Partner Agreement is related to the electronic exchange of information, whether the agreement is an entity or a part of a larger agreement, between each party to the agreement.
