Secure FTP Server Instructions

1. Go to <https://edisftp.bcbsks.com> to log in.
2. Log in with your Trading Partner number as the Username and the password received in the confirmation e-mail. Users logging in for the first time will be forced to update their password.

Password Change Requirements

To change your current password, you must enter and confirm your new password. We encourage you to make your passwords as strong as possible. You must follow these criteria:

- Passwords must be a minimum of 8 characters in length
- Passwords must include both alpha and numeric characters
- Special characters (such as # \$ % ' * ; @) must be included in your password
- A password cannot be used again for at least six generations. In other words, you must create at least six new passwords before you can use the first one again in the future
- Your password must be changed every 90 days

NOTE: Passwords are case sensitive.

SSH Key – Trading partners may use SSH authentication instead of a password after the first time logging in. Trading partners should work with IT staff on this option.

Instructions for Changing Password (after logging in for the first time)

1. Log into ASK SFTP Server
2. Click on **My Account** in the upper right corner of the screen



3. In the **Change Your Password** Section enter your old password
 - a. Choose **Use Suggested Password**
 - b. Choose **Type Custom Password**

Requirements:

- Must be at least 8 characters.
- Must not contain or resemble Username.
- Must contain at least one letter and one number.
- Must not contain dictionary words.
- Must contain both upper- and lower-case letters.
- Must contain at least one non-alphanumeric character.
- Must not match any of the previous 8 passwords.

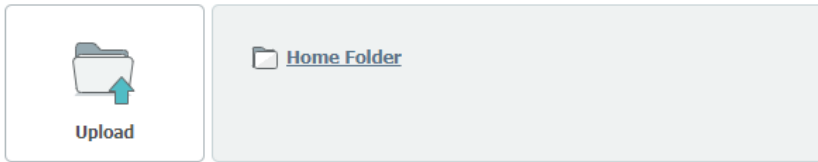
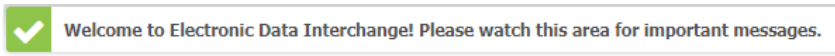
4. Click on **Change Password** to save new password.



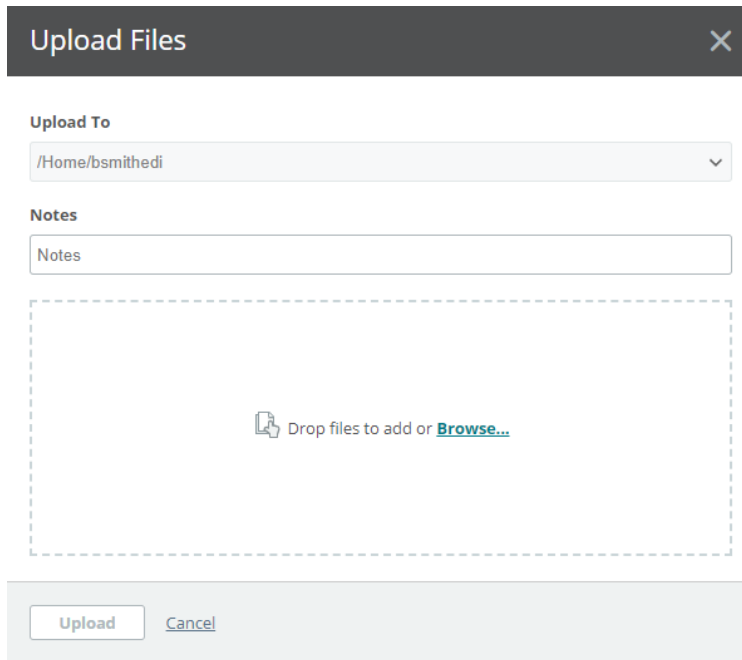

Uploading Files to ASK

1. Select the Upload button located toward the top of the Home page. **NOTE: Files will only be processed when uploaded to the HOME/EDI/Trading Partner Number path**



2. Browse to your claims file and select Upload.
